Hidden in the Hops:

Tiah Edmunson-Morton, founding curator of the Oregon Hops and Brewing Archives at Oregon State University Library, shares stories from her research into Oregon women who inherited and ran breweries before Prohibition. Edmunson-Morton highlights the importance and challenge of uncovering women's labor, and why local archives and historical societies are crucial to this work. The talk also considers how scholarship can offer rare inside views into the lived experiences of women whose labor shaped Oregon's agricultural and brewing economies.
